In order to approach this year's edition of the Frankfurt Book Fair, in which it is the Focal Theme,

Portugal has prepared a vast programme, of which the exhibition in the Portugal Pavilion is an important part. It was up to us to illustrate the motto

we adopted for the Portuguese participation: Portugal—Pathways into the world.

With this we intend to state that, in a certain manner, Portugal found itself on the pathways which it drew out across the planet, plaughing the seas

towards India or Brazil, cutting across the lands of Africa and Asia. It was in others that this country, ancient in its history and

frontiers, drank from the influences which make our culture so unique, starting out owing much to the Jewish contribution and the Arab

inheritance, working upon the Latin base, then open to the best which the African, American and Asian

peoples were able to provide us.

In this long journey throughout the Oceans of the world, Portugal developed a special relationship for the discovery and
